Pr: O holy, blessed, and glorious Trinity, one God,

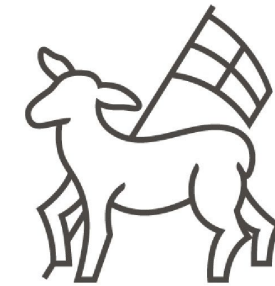
Q. 83. What is the communion in glory with Christ which the members of the invisible church enjoy in this life?
